WHAT IS 12A AND 80 G REGISTRATION?

12A and 80G registration pertain to tax exemptions for non-profit organizations in India. Specifically, these registrations allow NGOs and charitable organizations to obtain tax benefits under the Income Tax Act.

PROCESS FOR 12A AND 80G REGISTRATION



Preparation of Documents

Gather necessary documents, including the organization's registration certificate, bylaws, a detailed project report, and financial statements.



Application Submission

File the application for 12A and/or 80G registration with the Income Tax Department, typically through Form 10A (for 12A) and Form 10G (for 80G).



Verification & On-site Inspection

In some cases, the department may conduct a physical inspection of the organization's operations..




Approval

Upon successful verification, the department issues a certificate granting 12A and/or 80G status.



CRITERIA FOR 12A AND 80G REGISTRATION

- 
- **Non-Profit Nature:** The organization must operate solely for charitable purposes and cannot distribute profits.
 - **Documentation:** Must provide a constitution, memorandum of association, and financial statements.
 - **Activities:** The organization should demonstrate ongoing charitable activities that align with the definitions provided under the Income Tax Act.
 - **Application Timing:** Ideally, organizations should apply for 12A registration soon after their establishment to maximize tax benefits.
