Introduction to ISO 45001:2018

- International standard for Occupational Health and Safety (OH&S)
- Replaces OHSAS 18001
- Aims to reduce workplace injuries and illnesses
- Applicable to all types of organizations

ISO 45001 Certification Process Overview

1. Gap Analysis
2. Planning & Documentation
3. Implementation
4. Internal Audit
5. Management Review
6. Stage 1 Audit
7. Stage 2 Audit
8. Certification Issuance
9. Surveillance Audits

Step 1 – Gap Analysis

- Assess current OH&S practices
- Identify gaps against ISO 45001 requirements
- Prepare an action plan

Step 2 – Planning & Documentation

- Define OH&S policy and objectives
- Identify risks and opportunities
- Prepare procedures and manuals

Step 3 – Implementation

- Train employees
- Apply documented procedures
- Conduct risk assessments
- Engage stakeholders

Step 4 – Internal Audit

- Evaluate system effectiveness
- Identify non-conformities
- Take corrective actions

Step 5 – Management Review

- Review audit results
- Review OH&S objectives
- Evaluate compliance
- Decide improvements

Step 6 & 7 – External Certification Audit

Stage 1 Audit:

- Document review
- Readiness check

Stage 2 Audit:

- On-site verification
- Interviews & evidence collection

Step 8 – Certification Issuance

- Issuance of ISO 45001:2018 Certificate
- Valid for 3 years
- Subject to surveillance audits

Step 9 – Surveillance Audits

- Conducted annually
- Ensures continual improvement
- Maintain compliance
