WHAT IS REACH CERTIFICATION?

- REACH is a European Union regulation for the safe use of chemicals.
- It aims to protect human health and the environment.
- Applies to all chemical substances, not just those used in industrial processes.

OBJECTIVES OF REACH

- Ensure high level of protection
- Promote alternative hazard assessment methods
- Enhance EU industry competitiveness
- Enable free movement of substances in the EU market

KEY COMPONENTS OF REACH

- Registration: Gather information on substances
- Evaluation: Assess data and dossier quality
- Authorization: Control hazardous substances
- Restriction: Limit or ban risky substances

WHO NEEDS REACH CERTIFICATION?

- Chemical Manufacturers
- Importers
- Downstream Users such as product manufacturers

BENEFITS OF REACH COMPLIANCE

- Access to EU market
- Improved safety and health practices
- Enhanced brand reputation
- Legal and regulatory compliance

REACH REGISTRATION PROCESS

1. Identify substances
2. Collect required information
3. Prepare technical dossier
4. Submit to ECHA
5. Update registration as needed

DOCUMENTATION REQUIRED

- Safety Data Sheets (SDS)
- Chemical Safety Report (CSR)
- Technical Dossier
- Classification and Labeling Information

ROLE OF ECHA (EUROPEAN CHEMICALS AGENCY)

- Central authority for REACH
- Reviews and authorizes registrations
- Provides guidance and supports compliance

REACH COMPLIANCE MARKING (OPTIONAL)

- No official REACH mark exists
- Companies may display compliance statements on products
