ABOUT WPC

- Wireless Planning & Coordination (WPC) is a wing under the Department of Telecommunications, Ministry of Communications, Government of India.
- Responsible for frequency spectrum management and licensing of wireless devices in India.
- Mandatory for import/manufacture of wireless products.

WHY WPC REGISTRATION IS REQUIRED?

- Legal compliance for wireless product use/import
- Avoidance of penalties & confiscation
- Product eligibility for Indian market
- Ensures devices work within permitted frequency bands

PRODUCTS REQUIRING WPC APPROVAL

- Bluetooth devices
- Wi-Fi Routers
- Walkie-Talkies
- RFID Devices
- Drones
- Wireless Microphones
- IoT Smart Devices
- Others using unlicensed frequency bands

TYPES OF WPC LICENSES

1. ETA (Equipment Type Approval) – For wireless products working in unlicensed bands
2. Import License – For importing wireless devices
3. Dealer Possession License (DPL) – For dealing & possessing wireless equipment
4. Operating License – For operating wireless stations

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED FOR ETA

- Product brochure/specifications
- Radio test report from an accredited lab
- Applicant KYC (Aadhar, PAN, GST)
- Authorization letter (if applicable)
- Import Export Code (IEC)

WPC REGISTRATION PROCESS

1. Product Testing (if required)
2. Online Application Filing
3. Document Submission
4. Fee Payment
5. ETA Certificate Issuance

Timeline: 15–30 working days
